

Designing Guided Reading Through Thoughtful Teaching

About the Presenter:

Dawn De Guelle is the K-2 Literacy Collaborative[©] Coordinator and First Grade Teacher at Hortonville Elementary School. She is a trained teacher and coach through Literacy Collaborative [©] at The Ohio State University. She has over 20 years of classroom teaching experience as well as experience as a Reading Recovery teacher.

Workshop Outcomes:

Accurate assessment of student reading levels is the cornerstone of a good guided reading program. During this workshop, teachers will examine the Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark assessment system for obtaining students' guided reading levels. Next teachers explore the wealth of data that the assessment offers and learn how to use this data to drive their instruction. Instructors will also examine flexible grouping options and how to use cueing systems guided reading. Participants will walk away with a stronger understanding of text analysis. Time will be spent reflecting on strategic actions within the reading process. A careful look will be given to the Continuum of Literacy Learning as it pertains to Read Aloud, Writing about Reading and Guided Reading.

Experiences include: This workshop will provide a hands on analysis of various resources as they pertain to balanced literacy. (You may want to attend the Implementing Balanced Literacy within the K-2 Classroom workshop offered on June 18-19, 2012).
