## Trauma and loss knows no boundaries. Debriefing is the process of putting the incident (trauma) and the individual(s) reactions in perspective.



This workshop is designed to enhance the experience of school crisis team members serving in their role on school crisis response teams. Intervention consists of individual, group, and family participation; educational presentations; and debriefing and defusing trauma with victims, caretakers, teachers and crisis team members. Learn the differences between grief and trauma and how to identify trauma-specific reactions.

Trauma Response Teams, policies, procedures, interventions and postvention strategies are presented for violent and non-violent vet traumatic incidents involving students and/or staff. The workshop will addresses the potentially suicidal student,
