The new, national science standards designed by *Achieve, Inc.*, are being released on May 7, 2012. The standards document will be available for public comment for three weeks in May. The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction is sponsoring 20 listening sessions across the state, highlighting the standards and growing awareness of the process of their creation and implementation. This effort is being led by *Shelley Lee*, Department of Public Instruction Science Consultant and facilitated by the members of the Wisconsin State Science Leadership Team, who have been meeting regularly framing the implementation process of the standards in Wisconsin.
