Description: Preparing students to be "College and Career Ready" is an essential task that involves all teachers. Disciplinary Literacy, the ability to read, write, listen, speak, think critically and perform in different ways and for different purposes, becomes increasingly important as students pursue specialized fields of study in high school and beyond.

In this course, career and technical education teachers will refresh their literacy skills and learn new literacy strategies that can be immediately integrated into the classroom. Level I will provide an in-depth overview of the disciplinary literacy initiative in Wisconsin and introduce a variety of reading/writing strategies. All materials are provided to participants in a "train the trainer" format. It is the goal of Level I that participants will be able to share the concepts and strategies of disciplinary literacy with other educators in their school districts.
