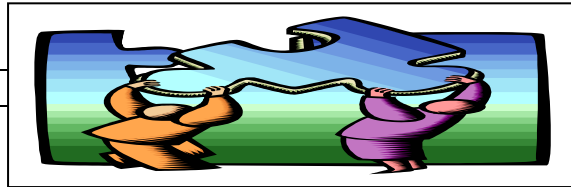

**Description:** Disciplinary Literacy in Career and Technical Education – Level II builds on the foundation strategies that were presented in Level I. Disciplinary Literacy is the ability to read, write, speak, listen, and think critically. Teachers will continue to refresh their literacy skills and learn new literacy strategies that can be immediately integrated into the classroom.

Level II will focus on strategies related to technical reading, technical writing, business and industry speaking/listening, and professional vocabulary. All materials are provided to participants in a "train the trainer" format. It is the goal of Level II that participants will be able to share more concepts and strategies of disciplinary literacy with other educators in their school districts. The course will be facilitated by Pamela Hilleshiem-Setz of CESA 5 and other guest presenters.
