Description: LLI is a small group intervention for students in kindergarten, first or second grade who are struggling to learn to read and write. This course has been designed for teachers using LLI as an intervention tool for the first time. The workshop series will help the participants assess, interpret and make placement decisions based on benchmark assessments, as well as organize and manage the LLI materials. Course instruction will include the LLI lesson framework, using the prompting guide as a teaching/acceleration tool, using known words to solve in reading and writing, and the use of writing to extend comprehension and word learning. Teacher proficiency will be the focus of this workshop series.

Requirements: Participants must have at least one Leveled Literacy Intervention series (Orange, Green, or Blue kits) they will be using with a group of students. In addition, participants need:

Prompting Guide I (included in LLI system)

Continuum of Learning (Fountas and Pinnell, 2009)

*A benchmark assessment system is an integral part of LLI. If your district does not use one, consider purchasing the Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark Assessment System 1 Videotaping capability
