Outcomes

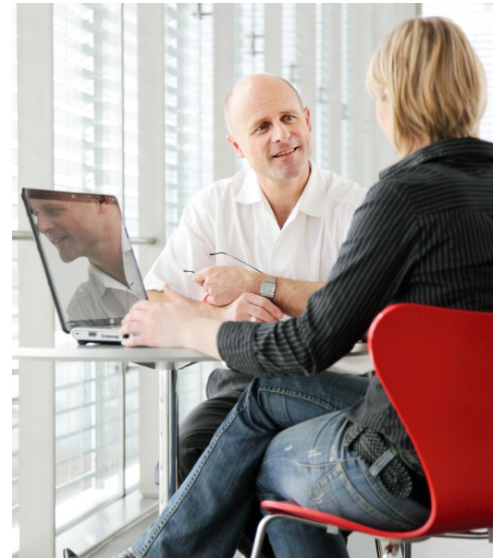
- Connect stakeholders
