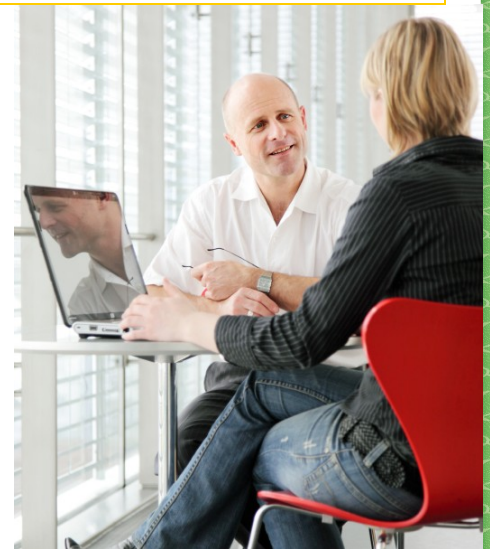
Who Should Attend
