**Kathy Schmitt** is a Literacy Coordinator for CESA 6. Before joining CESA6 she was a Reading Recovery Teacher and Reading Specialist for 10 years. After receiving training from The Ohio State University in Leveled Literacy Intervention (K-2), she trained more than 300 teachers in the use of Leveled Literacy Intervention (K-2). Kathy was trained by Ohio State University in LLI 3-8 in 2009 and supports many teachers in the development of lessons as well as acquiring the skills and strategies that are part of the intervention system. Kathy attended a two week training by Linda Dorn and Carla Sofos in Comprehensive Literacy and Comprehensive Intervention Models. She supports more than 100 teachers in the use the interventions.

**Nicole Lehr** is a Literacy Coordinator for CESA 6. Before joining CESA she was a Leveled Literacy Interventionist, Reading First Coordinator, and a Title I Teacher for various grades K – 8 in Reading and Math. She has extensive background knowledge of Fountas and Pinnell's Literacy Continuum and their LLI intervention program. She is excited to share her knowledge of literacy through consulting with school districts.

## Training Materials:

You will receive a schedule indicating which LLI and assessment materials are required for participants to bring to each class.

**Audience:** For teachers of Grades K-2 whose students are struggling with reading and writing.

LLI is a small group intervention for children in Kindergarten and Grades 1 and 2, who find reading and writing difficult to learn. Reading Recovery® is recommended for the lowest first grade students, and other low students may be serviced through Leveled Literacy Intervention® in groups of three. In Kindergarten and Grade 2, the children selected for the interventions are the lowest achievers in literacy in their grade level and are not receiving another intervention.

## Daily Instruction in LLI:

- ◆ Provides a daily 30 minute lesson for a small group of children
- ◆ Combines reading, writing, and specific work on sounds, letters, and words
- ◆ Gives explicit attention to the features of nonfiction and fiction texts
- ◆ Provides explicit teaching of effective strategies for writing and uses writing to extend understanding of texts and of words
- ◆ Emphasizes teaching for comprehending strategies
- ◆ Provides explicit teaching of effective and efficient strategies for expanding vocabulary

## Leveled Literacy Intervention Features:

- ◆ Fast-paced lessons that include explicit instruction in phonemics/phonics, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension
- ◆ Daily lesson guides with prescribed sequences of texts
- ◆ Instructional interactions between teachers and students with a 3:1 student-teacher ratio
- ◆ Emphasis on comprehension of fiction and non fiction texts with time engaged in reading continuous texts
- ◆ Continuum of student understandings to guide the series of lessons
