

## 2012-13 Support Seminars For Initial Educators

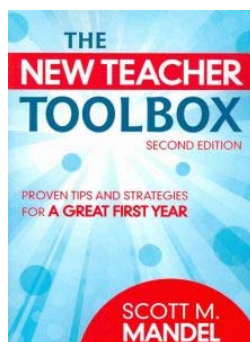
The CESA 5 Initial Educator Support Seminars are based on the Ten Wisconsin Educator Standards. Participants will reflect on the knowledge, skills and dispositions of the standards throughout the series of support seminars. Reflective practice is modeled as participants look at the standards and their own practice in their classrooms. Collaboration, competence and networking are emphasized. Mentors are invited to participate and provide their insight to the topics being discussed.

The CESA 5 Support Seminars can stand-alone or can be part of your district's professional development plan for initial educators. They are planned to fit into an educator's daily practice. The seminars are structured to share experiences and reflect on student outcomes within a regional support system.

### Cancellation Policy:

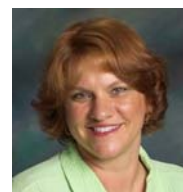
Refunds will be given only for cancellations received up to three business days before workshop start date.
