- An RtI action plan linked to existing school improvement goals/actions for either reading or mathematics
- Complete a baseline assessment of your school's RtI implementation using the School-wide Implementation Review.

- General education and special education teachers
- Specialists in the content area (either math or reading) addressed by school during this workshop. (Examples: reading specialist, Title One math, pupil services, G & T coordinator)
