## **Administrative Overview** Tier 2/Tier 3 AA696

#### **Description**

- This full day training provides an administrative overview of the system structures and commitments needed for effective implementation of Tier 2/3 of school-wide PBIS. This includes a description of the Tier 2 and 3 practices, data tools, and fidelity measures. Emphasis is on the continuum of support across a three-tiered system, highlighting data tools and behavioral interventions for groups of students and individuals, who require more than universal interventions to succeed.
- District and school-level leaders need to have a complete understanding of what the PBIS Tier 2/3 systems, data and practices entail so they can provide the necessary guidance to school staff as they move through Tier 2 and Tier 3 training and implementation. Repositioning of personnel to coach and facilitate specific PBIS Tier 2 and Tier 3 components become necessary at these levels. Administrators must be aware of needed roles/functions for Tier 2/3 implementation so they can anticipate and plan accordingly.

#### **Audience**

- District/school administrators including special education leaders, principals, internal/external PBIS coaches/specialized services personnel, such as social workers and school psychologists. Those attending must have attended Tier I training. Have 70% BoQ, 80% on TIC, 80% on SAS or 80/80 on SET.
