**Content:** Participants will be developing an acknowledgement plan, developing a chart of office-managed versus classroom-managed behaviors, establishing procedures for a continuum of interventions, evaluating the efficiency of "working smarter" among school teams, and creating a system for effective meetings.

**Who should participate:** Building level Universal team that includes the following: Building administrator, external and internal coaches, regular education teachers that represent grade levels, special education teacher, social worker and/or psychologist, specials teacher, paraprofessional, and family members.

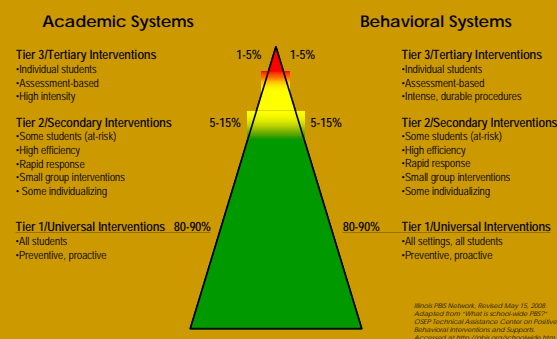
