# Writing Independent Reading Balanced Literacy Word Work Supported Reading

### **Workshop Objectives**

- Understand the Optimal Learning Model and be able to use the framework to plan instruction and assess student learning;
- Understand how interactive read-alouds, shared reading, guided reading and independent reading fit into the Optimal Learning Model framework;
- Develop knowledge of intelligence theories and use that knowledge to develop strategies to implement purposeful talk in the classroom;
- Participate in whole group, small group and partner discussions, view demonstrations of the components of the workshop model;
- Understand the reading/writing process and how ongoing assessment provide the specific support students need to extend their learning;
- Understand and develop mini-lessons that follow a structure that ensures student engagement by applying principles in many different contexts;
- Understand a variety of mini-lessons that help the reader/writer build effective processing of strategic actions while reading and writing independently, and talking about continuous text.
