Participants will learn simple strategies to jump start their own improvement plans. There will be built in time for group discussions with your peers and time for questions/answers and personal reflection. A short survey of participant's individual needs will be taken at the workshop. This information will be used to generate follow up sessions to be held at the following two Leadership Workshops on Feb 24 and March 24.

Participants will hear the story of the 10 year continuous school reform process, which includes many replicable organizational systems, policies and procedures. By building capacity among the staff and staying focused on the four critical areas of need, the teachers, parents and community came together to create a professional learning community and strong neighborhood school. Targeted improvement areas were:

- Curriculum continuity
- Achievement in literacy,
- Home school partnerships
- Climate and order

Sandy Gunderson has worked at every level within the K-12 school system. She has spent the last 30 years supporting the achievement of at-risk students in the Madison Metropolitan School District. Her most recent assignment was the principal at Mendota Elementary School. She was able to identify systems that need to be in place in order to double student achievement.
