The “flipped classroom” is an approach in which course instruction is delivered outside the classroom allowing for more time for interaction and participation in the face-to-face portion of the class.

This workshop is a **basic introduction** which will explore the foundations of a flipped classroom model.

Participant outcomes:

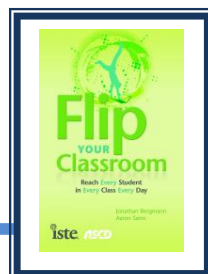
- Learn to use tools such as, Camtasia Studio, Snagit, Screencast-o-matic, and document and webcams to pre-record classroom presentations.
- Understand how to incorporate these recordings using Moodle and other web tools, and then access understanding with programs such as a quiz in Moodle.

What to Bring:

- *Bring an iPad, laptop or both!*
- *Install Camtasia Studio software on your laptop (30 day trial)*
- *Bring Digital Content to work on your own flipped video*

Presenter Jonathan Bergmann is considered one of the pioneers in the Flipped Class Movement. He co-wrote the book, **“Flip Your Classroom: Reach Every Student in Every Class Every Day.”** Jon, who has a Masters of Arts, Instruction Technology, is the Lead Technology Facilitator at Kenilworth District 38, in Kenilworth, Illinois. He has presented at countless conferences and workshops around the world and was involved with the Colorado Department of Education Stakeholders Committee in updating the Standard to reflect 21st Century Learning.
