Workshop Objectives

- Understand the Optimal Learning Model and be able to use the framework to plan instruction and assess student learning;
- Understand the components of Balanced Literacy and how it fits into the Optimal Learning Model framework ;
- Demonstrate an understanding of Allington's 6-T's
- Learn about the reading writing connection within the Balanced Literacy framework;
- Understand the reading/writing process and how ongoing assessment provides the specific support students need to extend their learning;
- Understand and develop mini-lessons that follow a structure that ensures student engagement by applying principles in many different contexts;
- Participate in whole group, small group and partner discussions, view demonstrations of the components of the Balanced Literacy framework.
