## Nonviolent Crisis Prevention Training

**Summary:** This refresher course is for people who have been previously (within the last three years) **certified** by the Crisis Prevention Institute. The course reviews nonverbal, verbal, and physical techniques to use safely in a crisis situation and offers recertification for one year.

#### Objectives for all participants:

- Learn to recognize signs of anxiety and pending disruption.
- Learn nonverbal and verbal de-escalation techniques.
- Develop knowledge and confidence in dealing with disruptive individuals.
- Learn personal safety tips/techniques in dealing with physically aggressive students.
- Learn techniques in nonviolent physical crisis intervention using a team approach.
- Gain recertification in nonviolent techniques to increase confidence level and expertise in dealing with crisis situations.
