Google Apps in Education

The workshop will begin with iPad basics including “must see” apps and websites for all educators. We will then explore apps that are designed specifically for the class you have chosen. Free Online Resources for Your Classroom

Explore the latest educational resources from the Internet. This session will introduce you to a digital learning library from PBS, resources from BadgerLink, and many more FREE resources that you can utilize in your classroom!

Reaching the 21st Century Learner

Current students are digital natives, so they instantly connect to technology. This helps them relate to the content of the message since they already connect to the medium of the message. Create a classroom project that will connect to your 21st Century students using tools and topics including: Edmodo, podcasting, wikis, & Prezi. Time will be provided to explore the tools demonstrated. By the end of the workshop you will have created a complete, working project that can be used yet this school year.

Moodle

This workshop provides educators with the skills and knowledge they will need to be an effective online instructor in order to meet the needs of 21st century students. Using Moodle, participants will become part of a community of learners as they build a solid foundation for their own online course. They will learn how to ensure that their learning outcomes are met through educationally sound activities that are measured through technology based assessments while providing opportunities for active learning.

Using SMART Boards

In this workshop, you will learn how to use SMART Notebook™ software to create a presentation that's rich with graphic detail and how to use SMART Board™ tools to quickly access functions that help you operate the interactive whiteboard more effectively. Activities appropriate for PK – 5th or 6th—12th grade will be highlighted.

Flipped Classroom

The “flipped” classroom is a way in which instruction is delivered outside the classroom which allows more time for exploration and student engagement in the face-to-face portion of the class. This workshop will explore the concept and some examples of how to flip your classroom.
