Topic #1-Connecting School Counselors to State Education Initiatives

Effective ILP development is a critical and creative thinking process that must involve activities designed to include self-exploration, career exploration, and career planning and management. This workshop will provide an overview of the ILP process, describe the benefits of ILPs, suggest the necessary components, and present a model of how school counselors' roles and responsibilities make them a natural partner in this process.
