Description

The Accessing the Curriculum Workshop will cover alternatives to standard text books. Students with disabilities can now be provided text in alternative formats including audio as well as text to speech. Expand your knowledge about accessible instructional materials (AIM) which includes alternative formats for materials and text books.

What are AIM? How are decisions made? Who needs AIM? How are AIM selected? What supports are needed for effective use of AIM? How does AIM differ from NIMAS (National Instructional Materials Accessibility Standard)?

Gain experience with a free online tool to help guide your team through the decision making process. Gain knowledge about the major ways you can obtain AIM and what types of services, formats and students served are available from the major service providers (American Printing House for the Blind, Bookshare, and Learning Ally). Learn how to obtain alternative text formats and then learn how to utilize them with students with disabilities.

Participants will leave with a wealth of information that can be used immediately with their own students.
