Description

This workshop will help participants to understand how to assess one of the building blocks for developing read skills for students who are non-verbal or who have cognitive disabilities. Phonemic discrimination (hearing the difference between sounds or phonemes) is very important, but how do you know if your students with limited verbal skills and or poor articulation are using word attack skills or even have the phonemic awareness to do so? This session will help teachers identify key literacy development stages and assess students (even those with severe physical & speech impairments) for phonemic and literacy development.
