## **Description**

This full day training is intended to inform school personnel how to implement **Effective Practices for DPI's New IEP: Postsecondary Transition Plan (PTP)** application and explore a variety of new transition resources. The PTP application includes a multitude of resources that can be utilized when creating high quality transition plans.

In addition, this training will preview and highlight the new and improved WSTI website and the new Transition Resources for Youth (TR4Y) website. Trainer will also highlight new tools for families and youth. This training has been developed in collaboration with DPI and WSTI.
