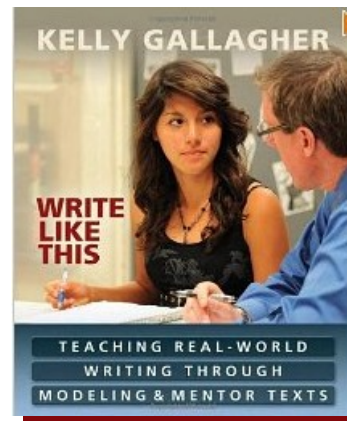
Nancy, CESA 10; Thersea, CESA 10; and Vanessa Sieg, Bloomer will help facilitate this study.
