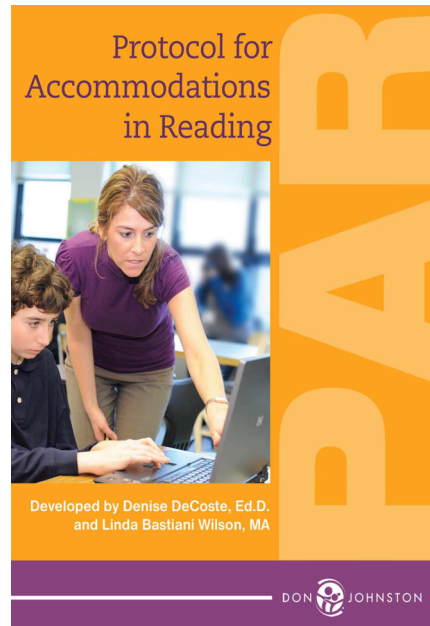


Hitting Par on the Reading Course:

The *Protocol for Accommodations in Reading (PAR)* is a free resource from Don Johnston, Inc. But once you download the 60 page document, how do you use it? This session will demonstrate how the PAR can help your IEP team identify the best accommodation for students with reading challenges. The development of the PAR, individual components, administration, examples of grade level texts and finally a sampling of reading accommodation tools, software, apps and e-text sources will be discussed. Hands-on time will be provided to explore the tools for making reading accommodations. The administration of the PAR will finally give IEP teams a systematic process for making evidence based decisions for reading accommodations.
