



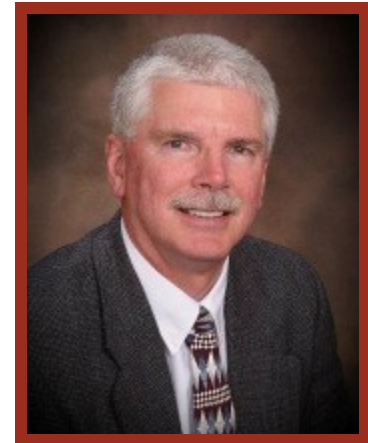

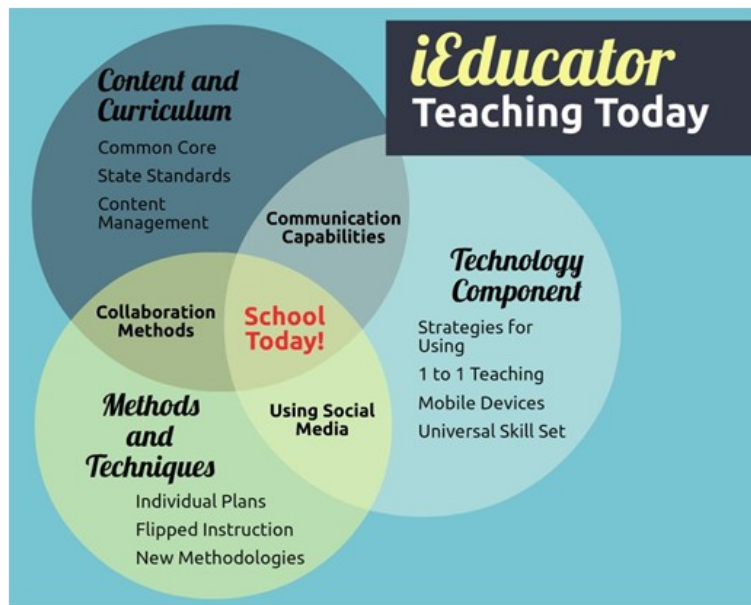
The afternoon session will provide participants time to discover new collaboration tools, distribution techniques, and innovative ways to present information with John serving as a guide.
