Implementing PBIS in your School: Tier 1/Universal System Part 3

Participants will revisit essential school-wide systems (data, teaching, acknowledgement, and interventions) and begin developing materials and a plan for tracking and responding to minor behaviors and implementation of PBIS in the classroom. Teams will use The Benchmarks of Quality to self-assess current implementation and action plan around identified needs.

<u>Target Audience</u>: Building level Universal team that includes: Building administrator, external and internal coaches, regular education teachers that represent grade levels, special education teacher, social worker and/or psychologist, specials teacher, paraprofessional and family members.

Participants should bring:

- ♦ School calendar and staff development days
- All artifacts/products from U100s and U200s such as behavioral matrix, cool tools/behavior lesson plans, acknowledgement system, T-chart of behavior, "working smarter" grid and any information shared with school community.
- Big Five behavioral data for previous 2-3 months (at least) for problem solving and action planning including data for Major ODRs and Minor data (if available)

<u>Objectives</u>: Understand the essential components of school-wide positive support systems that provide behavior supports to all students in both classroom and non-classroom settings.

- Review discipline data (Big Five graphs) and begin the process of data-based decision-making to meet student needs looking at both major and minor behavior data
- Review all of the Tier 1/Universal PBIS process by self-assessing with the Benchmarks of Quality and action planning on School-Based Unified Action Plan for each component
- Plan next steps in implementation through fine tuning of systems, data and practices in both classroom and non-classroom settings
- Plan for increased or continued stakeholder buy-in, implementation and sustainability
- Receive technical assistance from PBIS Network in developing and planning for implementation of schoolwide systems
