CESA 6 Alternative Schools Placement Process

Lynn Boreson will be joining us to talk about the CESA 6 Alternative Schools Placement Process. Lynn will review paperwork procedures and information on Functional Behavior Assessments (FBAs) and Behavior Intervention Plans (BIPs) with the directors of special education sending students to the alternative schools so everyone has a better understanding of what is procedural compliance. Even if districts don't currently have a student in the alternative program and/or don't anticipate using it, they should be aware of these issues if they have their own alternatives or "just in case" in the future.

Topics to be Discussed Include:

- Directors as IEP Team Members for Alternative Placements
- Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) Issues (shortened day, segregated facilities etc.)
- Strengthen LRE Statements in Individualized Education Programs (IEPs)
- Discussion for how/whether/when a student might return to their home school
- Strengthen Other Options Considered and Reasons Rejected in Placement Notices
- Required FBAs
- Goals/Objectives/Other Sections of the IEP Addressing Behavior, Especially Severity Requiring an Alternative Placement (this includes BIPs as defined in DPI Bulletin 07.01)
- Possible Additional Paperwork Requirements in Complaint Process
