Presenter: Jennifer Allen

Description:

Jennifer will share her framework for "layered coaching" as a way to build capacity in our schools. She will explore these coaching layers: being a resource; creating study groups; whole staff professional development; and supporting new teachers. As specialist and coaching roles expand, the layers of this work can be purposefully aligned with school and district goals. Fullar's concept of "Simplexity" connects closely to her work as she identifies specific areas of focus that provide important leverage points.

Jennifer will emphasize the importance of making meaning together...that we are all on the same team, and will also share her own pitfalls of learning and how her role has evolved and changed over time.

Objectives:

- Specific strategies will be explained regarding how coaches can keep children as the center of our conversations and help teachers use assessment to inform instruction, develop curriculum, and analyze student work.
- A demonstration on how the work can be threaded within and across the coaching layers will be shown.

About the Presenter:

Jennifer Allen is a literacy specialist in grades 3-5 for the Waterville, Maine School District, where she works as a literacy coach and leads professional development programs for teachers in a wide range of formats. She has presented her work to regional and national audiences including National Council of Teachers of English and International Reading Association. Jennifer is a contributing author to Choice Literacy. She is the author of: Becoming a Literacy Leader: Supporting Learning and Change; and A Sense of Belonging: Sustaining and Retaining New Teachers.
