

What will you accomplish?

- 1. Add the *Ensemble Content* resource to your Moodle site(s). You must be a confident Moodle user to attend.
- 2. Record/store/retrieve instructional video(s) through Camtasia Relay/Ensemble/Moodle.
- 3. In your Moodle, frame those instructional videos within assignments, assessments, discussion, reflection ...

IMPORTANT à What participants need to bring to this workshop ...

- 1. Laptop (Windows or Mac) with a web-cam & *Camtasia Relay* software (*Camtasia Fuse* on an iPad, iPhone, or Android phone/tablet will only record through the camera, NOT record the desktop). So far, only on Windows or Mac laptops, will *Camtasia Relay* record both camera and desktop.
