## Description:

In this workshop participants will learn about the Common Core Essential Elements (CCEE) and the Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM). CCEE are alternate achievement standards for students with severe cognitive disabilities that are clearly linked to common core grade level academic standards and promote access to the general education curriculum. The Dynamic Learning Maps system is designed to map a student's learning throughout the year. The system will use items and tasks that are embedded in day-to-day instruction. DLM along with the CCEE will provide the foundation for the new summative alternate assessment available in 2014-15 and provide consistency in expectations across grades and achievement levels.

- Demonstrate how the Common Core State Standards provide the foundation for Common Core Essential Elements (CCEE).

- Investigate the CCEE and understand the progression of skills embedded across grade levels and content.
- Review the new alternate achievement standards and achievement level descriptors based on the Common Core State Standards for ELA and Math.
