# Screening & Progress Monitoring Two-day Team-based session

The Screening and Progress Monitoring training will increase the capacity of school teams in creating effective and collaborative processes to collect and analyze data within an RtI framework.

## **Audience**

- Leadership staff, instructional staff, problem-solving team members, both general and special education teachers.
- Prior attendance at a WI RtI Foundational Overview/Framework
  Training is highly recommended.

#### **Outcomes**

- Learn steps for creating and sustaining a systemic screening and progress monitoring process
- Understand the purpose, components, and benefits of universal screening and progress monitoring in Wisconsin's RtI Framework
- Identify potential tools and data sources for use in a universal screening and progress monitoring process
- Learn processes for collaborative analysis of universal screening and progress monitoring results
- Learn strategies for digging deeper into student and school level screening results
- Learn strategies to use progress monitoring data for instructional decision-making
- Apply strategies to student and school level data
- Refine and evaluate a screening and progress monitoring process

## What to Bring

School teams are encouraged to bring a list of tools and data currently used in the school/district for screening and progress monitoring. If available, teams should bring, copies of current databased decision-making processes and/or decision rules used by collaborative teams in the school/district.
