#### **Who Should Attend**

School-level leadership teams of three or more, to include:

- Principal (essential)
- · General education and special education teachers
- Specialists in the content area (either mathematics or reading) addressed by the school during this workshop. Examples include reading specialist, Title One mathematics instructors, pupil services, gifted and talented coordinator, etc.

#### **Outcomes**

Teams will leave with:

- An in-depth understanding of Wisconsin's framework for Response to Intervention (Rtl)
- Activities, materials, and resources to support staff awareness, buy-in, and implementation of Wisconsin's Rtl framework
- An outline of their school's current implementation of the Rtl framework in either reading or mathematics
- · A baseline assessment of their school's Rtl implementation using the School-wide Implementation Review
- · A Rtl action plan linked to existing school improvement goals and actions for either reading or mathematics
- A plan to lead the change initiative in their school
