Wisconsin Rtl Framework: A Systems Approach to Implementing Response to Intervention

This TWO-DAY, TEAM-BASED workshop provides <u>secondary</u> school leadership teams with the fundamental knowledge and resources to develop their school's Rtl system

Who Should Attend

Secondary School-level leadership teams of three or more, to include:

- Principal (essential)
- · General education and special education teachers
- Specialists in the content area (either mathematics or reading) addressed by the school during this workshop. Examples include reading specialist, Title One mathematics instructors, pupil services, gifted and talented coordinator, etc...



Outcomes

Teams will leave with:

- An in-depth understanding of Wisconsin's framework for Response to Intervention (RtI)
- Activities, materials, and resources to support staff awareness, buy-in, and implementation of Wisconsin's Rtl framework
- · An outline of their secondary school's current Rtl framework implementation in either reading or mathematics
- A baseline assessment of their school's Rtl implementation using the School-wide Implementation Review.
- · A Rtl action plan linked to existing school improvement goals and actions for either reading or mathematics
- A plan to lead the change initiative in their school

What to Bring

Due to the interactive nature of this training, school leadership teams should bring:

- · A laptop with wireless connectivity
- The school's improvement goals and plans
- Student achievement goals and/or school-level trend data for either reading or mathematics (e.g. aggregated and disaggregated WKCE or benchmark assessment results).
