- If you received your educator license after August 31, 2004 and are issued an Initial Educator License by the DPI for the first time in a particular category, then you need to start a PDP!
- During this training, educators will learn through a web-based environment that prompts the development of a high-quality professional development plan to address self-identified learning needs based on professional reflection.
- Educators will be introduced to two different web-based programs to complete their PDP. As of December 1, 2013 the DPI will no longer be accepting paper applications.
- Educators will begin working on the various components of their PDP that need to be completed at their stage in the process.
- Apply your professional growth efforts and local initiatives while you work on your Professional Development Plan for license renewal.

Audience:

Initial Educators must have regular employment with licenses expiring June 30, 2016, 2017 or 2018

Professional Educators must have regular employment and be in Year 1 of the Professional Educator license cycle
