PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention System (LLI) is a small-group, supplementary intervention designed for children who find reading and writing difficult. LLI is designed to bring children quickly up to grade-level competency. LLI serves those students who need intensive support to achieve grade-level competency. LLI can be delivered by the classroom teacher, Title I teacher or reading interventionist, ESL teacher or the special education teacher.

Four systems are available for LLI. Each supports instruction at different levels on the F&P Text Level Gradient™, A-Z:

Orange System: Levels A through C

Green System: Levels A through J

Blue System: Levels C through N

Red System: Levels L through Q

Gold System: Levels O through T (available September 1, 2013)



BENCHMARK ASSESSMENT TRAINING

Fountas & Pinnell Benchmark Assessment System helps assess students at the entry and exit points for the LLI system. Both systems are based on the F&P Text Level Gradient™. A–Z, which is correlated to grade level. This training is essential to anyone not familiar with F&P's Reading Record as it is a part of the LLI lesson framework. This training is also for anyone starting out with the BAS kit for the first time. We will learn how to use this tool to benchmark and progress monitor students. The training will include how to administer, score and analyze the reading record to make instructional plans to increase student achievement.

*Kit is not required for anyone with an LLI kit as it is built into the system, but it is recommended.

ORANGE/GREEN/BLUE KIT

LLI's primary kits provide systematic intervention options for students in grades K-3. Learn the structure of these systems, practice instructional procedures, and get tips/tricks on getting started.

*Districts will receive an on-site follow up training including modeling of lessons.

RED/GOLD KIT

LLI's new Red and Gold Kits provide intervention options for inter-mediate children in grades 3- 6. With significant structural differences, this kit includes age-appropriate activities, including novel studies, genre studies, test prep, and a focus on deeper comprehension demanded by the CCSS. Participants will dig into this intervention kit and leave pre-pared to use it with their students.

*Districts will receive an on-site follow up training including modeling of lessons.



MAKING INSTRUCTIONAL DECISIONS WITHIN LLI FRAMEWORK
