Laura Owens, Associate Professor, UW-Milwaukee **Presenter:**

The workshop will focus on learning the skills necessary for being an effective job coach. It will address structured intervention techniques to help the student/employee learn to perform job tasks to the employer's specifications and to learn the interpersonal skills necessary to be accepted as a worker at the job site and in related community contacts. The use of natural supports, least prompt hierarchy, evaluation and fading assistance as well as other topics will be covered.

Participants will:

- · Understand the process of job/task analysis, job accommodations and the use of systematic instruction
- · Utilize the guidelines for the least prompt hierarchy and data collection
- · Identify the importance of building relations at the job site
- · Learn the value of developing natural supports
- · Review the need for evaluation, on-going support and fading assistance from the job site
