### Description:

Oral language is key to learning across all areas of the prekindergarten and kindergarten curriculum. Language learning involves putting words together in meaningful ways, recognizing the structure or grammar of the language, developing a strong oral vocabulary, and hearing the sounds in words. This session will focus on how teachers can support oral language learning, including the development of children's speaking and listening vocabularies.

### Workshop Objectives

- Understand how to manage and design classrooms that support meaningful learning experiences through play with teachers as facilitators of self-regulated student learners
- Focus on assessment using informal and formal observations that provide evidence to support language development and early literacy concepts through intentional conversational interactions
- Explore the Continuum of Literacy Learning for the behaviors and understandings to notice, teach, and support in order to present playful and joyful yet appropriate, purposeful, and powerful experiences and opportunities to nurture young readers and writers, including learning about letters, sounds, and words
