## **Description:**

The purpose of this session is to help teachers think about how writing and reading are closely connected processes. Teachers will also gain an understanding of how children's early attempts at writing help children learn about literacy and



show teachers what they are noticing and learning.

### **Workshop Objectives**

- Understand how to manage and design classrooms that support meaningful learning experiences through play with teachers as facilitators of self-regulated student learners
- Focus on assessment using informal and formal observations that provide evidence to support language development and early literacy concepts through intentional conversational interactions
- Explore the Continuum of Literacy Learning for the behaviors and understandings to notice, teach, and support in order to present playful and joyful yet appropriate, purposeful, and powerful experiences and opportunities to nurture young readers and writers, including learning about letters, sounds, and words
