

School-Wide Systems for Student Success: A Response to Intervention (Rtl) Model



#### Internal Coach

- Provide information and building-based technical assistance on best practices, current research and funding sources
- Keep team focused/functioning
- Understand the use of data-locally, state-wide and nationally

#### **External Coach**

- Provide information and technical assistance on best practices current research and funding sources
- Know and anticipate local needs and resources
- Keep teams focused/functioning

#### **Principal**

- Develop short/long term goals for building positive behavior supports, include as a top three School Improvement (SIP) Goal
- Make a commitment to developing strong communication among staff/parents/community, budget needs and allow time for team to meet regularly
- Connect building with central office
- Ensure data collection tools are in place

#### **Administrator**

- Make a commitment to provide leadership around PBIS throughout the district
- Communicate district goals/expectations to building administrators and request regular updates
- Ensure resources are available (coordinator/coach), budget
- Ensure data collection tools are available and data are used to make informed decisions
- Connect local positive behavior supports with state and federal initiatives
