Description:

The Common Core State Standards (CCSS) are the first step in providing our young people with a high-quality education. It should be clear to every student, parent, and teacher what the standards of success are in every PK – 12 classroom. Join us in learning more about the CCSS, Revised CTE Academic Standards, Disciplinary Literacy, Technology Tools, and Strategies for Writing Curriculum. Special focus will be placed on using the "Build Your Own Curriculum" (BYOC) software. However, you are not required to use BYOC.

Participants will develop an "Individualized Learning Plan" during the first class meeting and then work independently to complete their assignments. You will have 3 weeks to complete the writing of at least one course or core discipline curriculum. Participants will meet in person with the instructor at predetermined times and as a large group, we will meet online once per week using "GoToMeeting". ©
