# **Description**

This foundation workshop thoroughly explores the features and characteristics that comprise autism spectrum disorders (ASD) including Asperger syndrome and high functioning autism. Numerous examples of "behaviors" in relation to the features and characteristics of ASD will be given. This foundation workshop is a priority for professionals and family members to develop an understanding of ASD from which to develop appropriate programming and intervention strategies.

## **Workshop Objectives**

- Develop an understanding of the unique features and characteristics associated with autism spectrum including Asperger syndrome and high functioning autism.
- Learn the DPI educational eligibility criteria for identifying a child with an autism spectrum disorder as well as the DSM IV eligibility criteria.
- Explore the unique learning/thinking/processing differences associated with autism spectrum disorders including Asperger syndrome and high functioning autism.
- Review sensory, communication and social differences in relation to appropriate accommodations/modifications to increase the child's understanding and functional/ meaningful independence.
- Increase awareness of the educational implications for students on the spectrum Including curriculum, environmental modifications, homework and behavioral issues.
