iTunes U

- Allows you to organize all your information and resources into one location. Any images, worksheets, videos, apps, ebooks, web links, or anything else electronic you can think of are all arranged in one location.
- Have you ever wished there was a way to eliminate printing worksheets and giving students multiple copies of resources? iTunes U might be the answer you are looking for.
- An iTunes U course can be as simplistic or elaborate as the teacher chooses. Teachers can create selfpaced courses or create a course with specific due dates for assignments.
- This class will cover the process of creating your own iTunes U course from setting up an account to assigning the course to students. Now it's easier to create your own course for iPad using iTunes U!

Resources participants need to bring:

- •Picture of yourself (300 X 300 pixels or larger) .png or .jpg
- +Image for the content of your course (600 X 600 pixels or larger) .png or .jpg
- +Laptop (MAC or PC) with current version of Safari or Firefox. (Safari works best)

✓A few of your electronic resources you might use in your iTunes U course. (video, apps, audio, images, documents, web links, etc...)

✓ An iOS device (iPad, iPhone, iPod touch)
