This professional development is designed to be an ongoing process to improve mathematics instruction at the classroom level by:

- teaching and receiving high quality instructional feedback from Dr. Tim McNamara and peers,
- observing and modeling mathematical coaching at the classroom level,
- applying a coaching model for mathematics instruction,
- fostering leadership for the implementation of a coaching model for mathematics instruction, and
- supporting a continuous improvement model at the classroom, building and district levels.

Change is complicated...

- Instructional coaching can help alleviate some of the burden of change.
- Instructional coaching is on-site professional development who teach educators how to use proven teaching methods.
- Instructional coaching is part of the change process. Coaches work one-on-one with teachers to make it easier to adopt the instructional methods that can make a
 difference to students' success.

Dates: Teachers participating will be involved in the Math Center 6-8 days throughout the year. The number of days is dependent on instructional coaching schedules and teacher availability. Semester 1: Teachers will be engaged in the coaching process and receive instructional feedback. Semester 2: Teachers will be facilitating/practicing coaching and giving instructional feedback.

- September 29, 2010—1-Day coaching training facilitated by Dr. Deb Kneser—CESA 6, 2300 State Road 44, Oshkosh (Lunch On Your Own)
- October 21, November 9, December 14, 2010; February 22, March 24, April 19, 2011—Teacher observations/feedback and coaching modeled—In District
- January 20, 2011—1-Day coaching training—CESA 6, 2300 State Road 44, Oshkosh (Lunch On Your Own) All trainings are from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm.

Cost: Dependent on number of participants. Estimate: \$2,000 per person for this year-long professional development (approximately 6-8 days of contact – combination of face-to-face and on-line sessions = \$250.00 to \$333.00 per session). Must have a total of 25 combined participants to offer this opportunity)

Location: SEE ABOVE—Center format will combine approximately 6-8 face-to-face contact days and on-line/distance collaboration and support opportunities. The structure of the network meetings is negotiable and will be customized based on cohort needs.
