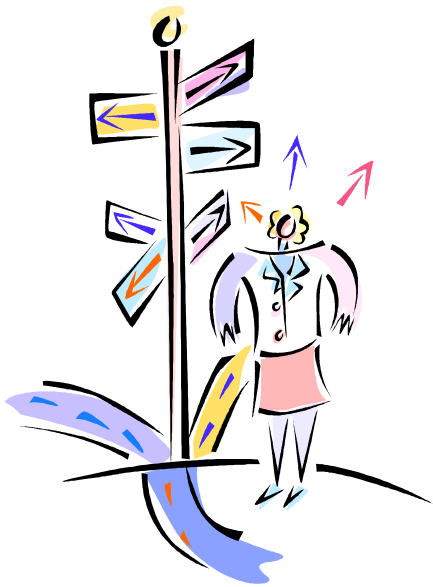




CESA 3 ELEMENTARY NETWORK MEETINGS (2013-14)
