The Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards (WMELS) are derived from research in the domains of early learning and development and apply to all settings in which children receive care and education. These early learning standards are intended to align to Wisconsin's Common Core State Standards and provide early learning opportunities that support children's success across environments and in the future.

Activities will emphasize:

- How to implement the teaching cycle (assessment, planning, implementation) using the WMELS as a guide;
- How to plan for and implement developmentally appropriate activities with targeted objectives;
- How to assess children's growth & development using informal & formal assessment strategies;
- How WMELS links to YoungStar
- How to meet the needs of diverse learners through differentiated learning activities (RtI)
