C100: Coaches and Admin Training

Participants will gain an awareness of the philosophical underpinnings of PBIS, the role of coaches in the PBIS implementation process, the skills needed for effective coaching and the role of coaches in the use of data for decision-making. They will become familiar with the basic rationale and feature of school-wide PBIS by defining these roles as well as functions, outcomes and competencies. System assessments will be addressed as well as the roles and functions of teams and the Tier 1 Universal System components

U100/U200: Tier 1 Tuesday, 10/29/2013 and Monday, 11/25/2013 (8:30am-3:30pm)

Participants will learn the systems, data and practices imbedded in PBIS implementation. The team will draft school-wide Behavioral Expectations, create Behavioral Matrices and plan for team development. On Day 2, participants will build on their work from Day 1 and will continue by developing an acknowledgment plan, developing a chart of office-managed vs. classroom-managed behaviors, establishing procedures for a continuum of interventions, evaluating the efficiency of "working smarter" among school teams and creating a system for effective meetings

UTA300: Implementing PBIS in Your School

Participants will revisit essential school-wide systems (data, teaching, acknowledgement and interventions) and use the Team Implementation Checklist (TIC) to self-assess current implementation and action plan around identified needs. Participants will also look at the Benchmarks of Quality (BOQ) to begin to understand the use of the tool in self-evaluation. Participants will review all of the Tier 1 Universal PBIS processes by working through the PBIS TIC and action planning based on the School-Based Unified Action Plan for each component; plan implementation through development of systems, data and practice; plan for stakeholder buy-in, implementation and sustainability; and receive technical assistance from PBIS Network in developing and planning for implementation of school-wide systems.
