

Leveled Literacy Intervention

Judy was trained as a Literacy Coach by Linda Dorn and also received training directly from Fountas & Pinnell in using the LLI resources.



Description: LLI **Red** and **Gold** are small group interventions for children in Grades 3 and 4, (or upper level students reading significantly below grade level) who find reading and writing difficult to learn. Teacher proficiency will be the focus of this workshop series.

Leveled Literacy Intervention Features:

- Fast-paced (45 minute) lessons, that include explicit instruction in structural analysis, vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension.
- Daily lesson guides with prescribed sequences of texts.
- Instructional interactions between teachers and students with a student-teacher ratio up to 4:1.
- Emphasis on comprehension of fiction and non-fiction texts with time engaged in reading continuous texts.
- Continuum of student understandings to guide the series of lessons.

Requirements: Prompting Guide I (included in LLI system) if available
Continuum of Learning (Fountas and Pinnell, 2009) if available

Participants do not need to have purchased either kit prior to attending; samplers will be used to examine the framework.
