Program Overview

The Fountas & Pinnell Leveled Literacy Intervention System (LLI) is a small-group, supplementary intervention program designed to help teachers provide daily, small-group instruction for the lowest achieving children in the early grades.

- ◆ LLI is designed to be used with small groups of young children who need intensive support to achieve grade-level competency.
- ◆ Participants include low-achieving children who are not receiving another supplementary intervention.
- ◆ English language learners can also benefit from LLI. Each LLI lesson provides specific suggestions for their support.



LLI Primary: Orange, Green, and Blue **October 11, 2013**

LLI's primary kits provide systematic intervention options for students in grades K-3. Learn the structure of these systems, practice instructional procedures, and get tips/tricks on getting started.

LLI in the Intermediate Grades **(Red and Gold Kits)** **November 5, 2013**

LLI's new Red and Gold Kit provides intervention options for children in grades 3-8. With significant structural differences, this kit includes age-appropriate activities, including novel studies, genre studies, and a focus on deeper comprehension demanded by the Common Core State Standards. Participants will leave ready to use this intervention to support older learners.
