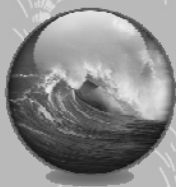

What is Co-Teaching?

- Two or more adults
- Simultaneously instructing a group of students
- In a coordinated fashion

“Collaborative teaching is a service delivery structure in which teachers with different knowledge, skills, and talents have joint responsibility for designing, delivering, monitoring, and evaluating instruction for a diverse group of learners in general education classrooms.”
